JESUS

Joseph's father gave him authority over his brothers	Jesus was given all authority from the Father.
Joseph escaped death by going into Egypt.	Jesus escaped death by going into Egypt
He was betrayed by his brothers, the sons of Jacob/Israel.	Jesus was betrayed by his brothers, the sons of Israel—the Jews.
Joseph's brothers believed he was dead, but he was found to be alive.	Jesus was believed to be dead, but He was found to be alive. He was Resurrected from the dead.
Joseph was the beloved son of Jacob/Israel.	Jesus is a "son" of Israel (descendant) and He is also the beloved Son of God.
Joseph was an innocent man condemned between two guilty men (Baker and Cupbearer)	Jesus was a innocent man condemned between two men on a cross
One guilty man perishes (Baker), one is saved (Cupbearer)	One guilty man perishes (man on left), one is saved (thief on right)
Vocations of Bread and Wine with the men having dreams	Jesus is the Bread and Wine
Joseph asks to be remembered	Jesus asks to be remembered
Joseph received authority over all Egypt	Jesus was given all authority from the Father.
People bowed the knee to Joseph	People bow the knee to Jesus
Joseph provided bread in a famine to people all over	Jesus is the Bread of Life for the whole world
